

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS Part 2 (Protocol COVID-19)

Rallye Défi Petite Nation, September 9,10 and 11 2021

COVID-19 Protocol

We will follow the guidelines and recommendations prescribed by CARS in the 2020-08 announcement dated July 29, 2020 as well as the Quebec public health recommendations for external events in effect at the time of the event.

We will review and update our COVID-19 protocol one week prior to the event. It will be emailed to all registered competitors and volunteers. Until further notice, here are the highlights:

General:

1. Volunteers, officials and competitors will need to register online.

 2. Competitors : [Competitor Registration](#)
2. All officials, workers and team members must wear a mask (face cover) indoors as well as in places where the physical distance of 1 meter will be impossible to respect.
3. The exceptions to this rule apply only to the driver and co-driver when wearing their helmets or working together in the car.
4. All officials and volunteers must read and sign a COVID-19 Risk Acknowledgment when registering as a volunteer. Online registration cannot be completed without the acknowledgment and signature of the volunteer.
5. Spectators will not be allowed in the service park.
6. The Park Exposé will be prohibited.
7. Spectator areas and gatherings of spectators will be prohibited.
8. Post-rally events, such as banquets and festivities, will be prohibited (Until further notice)
9. During the podium ceremony, everyone must respect the distance of 1 meter. Ceremonies will be reserved for team members, officials on duty, the CRC TV film crew and a maximum of 6 accredited photographers.
10. Reminders promoting physical distancing, face covering and hand washing will be posted in all areas where physical distancing is difficult to maintain (HQ, Volunteer Center, Meeting locations).

Compétiteurs et équipes de service

1. The registration of competitors will only be done online at the following link: [Compétitor Registration](#)
2. The teams will have a maximum of 6 people, including driver and co-driver. Each member of the service team will be required to wear a face cover and the bracelet provided by the organization. The purpose of this measure is to restrict the number of people on the site in connection with COVID-19.
3. When registering, you will need to provide us with the names of the 4 people on your service team. Changes are possible until registration closes. A link to modify your registration is provided to you in the registration confirmation email.
4. Members of the service teams must register as volunteers by following the following link: [Volunteer Registration](#). They will have to choose the "Administration" preferred task and enter the name of their team (s) in the form`s comments section.
5. All competitors and their team members must read and sign the CARS waiver and COVID-19 acknowledgment by following the following link: [CARS Waiver and COVID-19 Risk Recognition](#).
6. Travel to other service areas is prohibited. Teams that share mechanics can do so, however they must indicate in the registration form (comments section) with which team they share mechanics.
7. A maximum of two (2) vehicles per crew will be allowed to circulate on the site, excluding the rally car. You must provide the necessary size of your service area.
8. In connection with COVID-19, the technical inspection of vehicles this year will be a little different. It will take place directly in the service area of each of the crews. These are the inspectors who will move between the teams. The exact schedule and procedure will be sent to you later.
9. At a stage start, finish, at service or any other major stop control, the co-pilots will enter their times on the control cards using the time displayed by the controller on a white board (EZ Track tablet), outside the vehicle
