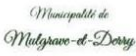

8. Type of Event

Rallye Défi Petite Nation is a performance rally of 540 kilometers (approximately 340.39 km regionally), including 198.40 km of special stages (129.18 km RSQ and OPRC). Stages will be held on asphalt, gravel and sand roads.

The Montpellier special (4km) is mainly on asphalt (in total 8 km).

Changing tires will be permitted

National :

- There will be a reseeding on Friday evening after the last stage and the cars will leave the Montpellier service on Saturday morning in reseed order.
- The reseeding (after leg A - first stage) (after leg B - second stage) will be made on the basis of the results obtained during the stages.
- The new starting order will be established from the total of the positions in all the ranking events, less the worst. In case of a tie, the total time will decide.
- The new starting order for each leg will be posted at Headquarters on Friday evening as soon as possible after the arrival of the last car.

Régional :

- The regional teams will leave following the national teams from the Montpellier service area

10. Registration

The registration period begins with the first publication of the supplementary regulations.

National entries will be accepted until Wednesday, September 7, 2022 at 9 p.m.

Regional entries will be accepted until Friday, September 9th, 2022 at 12:00 p.m.

Vehicles of the following categories will be eligible at the start:

- Open 4WD
- Open 2WD
- Production 4WD
- Production 2wd

There is no maximum number of registrations.

Registration for Rallye Défi Petite Nation will be done only online and involves 2 mandatory steps:

Penalties :

- A penalty of CA\$200 (national championship) or CA\$100 (RSQ/OPRC) will be added to any registration received after August 30, 2022.
- Any check post-dated after August 31, 2022 will not be accepted. Your check confirms your registration.
- An NSF check must be replaced before the start of the rally by adding a penalty of \$100.

Refunds :

- 100% of the entry fee will be refunded if notice of withdrawal is given before Monday September 5th 2022 at 10 h (H.A.E.).

National & Regional :

Fees will be refunded at 75% if notice is given by 6:00 p.m. (EDT) on Wednesday, September 7th, 2022.

After 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 7th, 2022, no refunds will be made.

12. Insurance

Liability Insurance :

Event participants are covered by third party liability, bodily injury and property damage insurance up to \$5,000,000 CDN

Health/Medical Insurance:

Teams (driver, co-driver and service team) from outside of Quebec must ensure that they have personal health insurance coverage providing basic medical care coverage.

Coverage Period:

Event insurance coverage covers teams during special stages only. Civil liability and damage outside the stages are the responsibility of each competitor's automobile insurance policy. Insurance coverage for the event ends at the end of the rally or if the team withdraws.

13. Awards

Trophies and awards will be posted at the rally Headquarters on Wednesday, September 7, 2021.

14. Eligibility

As per CARS regulations, verification of the vehicle eligibility may be done at scrutineering, during the event, and/or post rally.

The vehicles will be classed in accordance with the CARS National Rally Regulations for the national event and ECRC, and the RSO and RSQ Regulations (for regional event).

The competitors must have valid CARS licenses and respect all rules and regulations.

15. Timing & Scoring

Timing, Controls and Scoring will be as per NRR - 15, 16 and 17. Timing cards will be used.

A competitor should start every minute. The first 5 drivers (or the equivalent number of drivers with a speed factor greater than 85) will have an additional minute.

All times given will be elapsed times. To calculate the time out at the end of a stage, the competitor will use the long time, unless the time spent in the stage is longer.

If this should happen, the competitor will use the time in at finish in hours and minutes.

16. Mandatory Tracking System (RallySafe)

RallySafe will be used at Rallye Défi Petite Nation for vehicle tracking. All competitors will be required to purchase and pre-install a [RallySafe Permanent Installation Kit](#) from the RallySafe Store.

This is a one-time purchase and install that stays with the car.

The RallySafe fitting kit must be installed before the RallySafe unit is installed at scrutineering. Cars not meeting this requirement will not pass scrutineering.

17. Timing Procedure

Section 15.5 du RSN et RNR de CARS

The timing system used will be that of RallySafe. Using this system will allow the scoring team to view the results in near real time.

A manual timing system with whistle and time cards and logsheets will also be used in case of failure of the RallySafe system and for the correction of errors if necessary.

All time cards will be given to competitors upon registration. Competitors must have the correct time card at each stage.

No time correction request will be accepted if there is a difference of 1 second or less between the 2 timing systems.

18. Judges of Fact

In addition to GCR 6.3 which outlines both Judges of Fact and what they may judge, arrival time in a control zone and speed registered on a radar gun will also be facts that may be judged.

19. Vehicle Advertising

Competitors must display on their vehicles the CARS identification materials (numbers, door panels, windshield banner which will be available at registration) as well as event decals as provided by the organizers. Refusal will entail exclusion from the event.

20. Fuel Stops and Servicing

The service book allows assistance planning.

It includes a chart showing the total distance and stage distance run before each service or refueling stop.

The distance between refueling stops will not exceed 116 kilometers.

As soon as the service zone is open, all refueling must be done in the refueling zone. Fuel containers must not be left in the refueling area overnight.

The service area will be considered, from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., as a parc fermé and any repair, assistance or refueling is strictly forbidden under penalty of penalty according to NRR 16.8.4 (exclusion).

National

One fuel stop ONLY will be scheduled between stages #1 and #2.

Except for the conditions mentioned in NRR 18.1.8.1, the service is only authorized at the places provided.

Competition vehicles, as soon as they have clocked in at the major time control at the end of stage A, may not leave the service area before 07:00 on Saturday.

21. Parc Fermé Inspection

Any car finishing the rally in the top three positions of any championship (national or regional or in class) may be inspected if deemed necessary. Reassembling the removed parts will be the competitors' responsibility.

22. Miscellaneous

Communications

We will use HAM radio system. We wish to thank the local Club(s) for getting involved in this important aspect of the event. If you know people who use this type of communication and who want to help us, spread the word. The people of CRALL as well as the members of the organization will appreciate their possible involvement.

The majority of communications will be in French, with some in English on occasion or as required.

Distances

Distances in the route book and service book will be given in kilometers.

Accommodations

It is the responsibility of each team to coordinate their accommodation. Visit the Rallye Défi Petite Nation website for a list of options available to you.

Média

The event will be filmed

Reseeding

National

Reseeding (after leg A – first day) (after leg B – second day) will be based on the results from the stages. The new starting order will be established based on the total of all stages, minus the worst result. In case of a tie, total time will be the deciding factor. The new starting order for each leg will be posted at Rally HQ as soon as possible after the arrival of last competitor.

Régional

There will be no reseeding during the rally.

23. RECCE (National & Regional)

All crews registered for the rally will be able to take part in RECCE. If you are registered for National or National & Regional, see National Schedule for date/time of National RECCE. If you are registered for Regional only, see Regional Schedule for date/time of Regional RECCE

It is important to note that we provide a basic road book showing major changes in direction.

Reconnaissance is used to clarify the instructions in the stages, and no one is obliged to participate.

Competitors may reproduce all or part of the notes taken by other competitors.

24. Registration Procedure

National

Competitors must register at the rally headquarters on Wednesday, September 7, 2022 between 6 p.m. and 9 p.m. to obtain the necessary documents to participate in the RECCE.

Regional

Competitors must register at the rally headquarters on Friday, September 9, 2022 between 10:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. (noon) to obtain the necessary documents to participate in the RECCE.

All RECCE will be done in parade.

25. Schedule

RECCE must be carried out in compliance with the timetable in the program. Breach of this regulation will result in refusal to start the rally

26. Restrictions

The maximum speed for RECCE in all classification events is 60 km/h or the legal limit displayed, whichever is lower. Competitors are reminded that these roads will be open to the public and competitors should expect on-coming traffic.

The installation and use of radar detection equipment is prohibited during reconnaissance.

Breach of Article NRR 13.6.12 about RECCE maximum speed, car usage and radar detection will be penalized as mentioned in the NRR.

Observation controls will be used to verify compliance with 20.3.1

Competitors will be issued with a RECCE card Wednesday, September 7 from 18h00 to 21h00, which must be carried in the car for the duration of the RECCE. This card will be stamped appropriately recording every run on each special stage. Failure to produce this card will result in refusal to participate in the reconnaissance.

Competitors will be issued reconnaissance numbers that will be fixed to the outside of the rear side windows of the car. Failure to mount these numbers correctly or not displaying them will result in refusal to participate in the RECCE.

Competitors must use a street licensed, unmarked vehicle.

Provision is made for a maximum of two passages through each special stage for each entered crew during the RECCE. The crews are not allowed to drive counter-rally on the special stages, unless given particular directions to do so by the organizer, his representative or the police

National

- Observation checks will be used to verify compliance with NRR 20.3.1
- Crews are authorized to run a maximum of 2 times in each stage during RECCE.

Régional

- Crews are authorized to run a maximum of 1 time in each stage during RECCE. RECCE will be done in a convoy and organizer course notes will be provided)

27. Podium

There will be two podiums at the end of the rally (overall and 2WD) each for the CRC and two podiums (general +2WD) for the RSQ/ OPRC events combined.

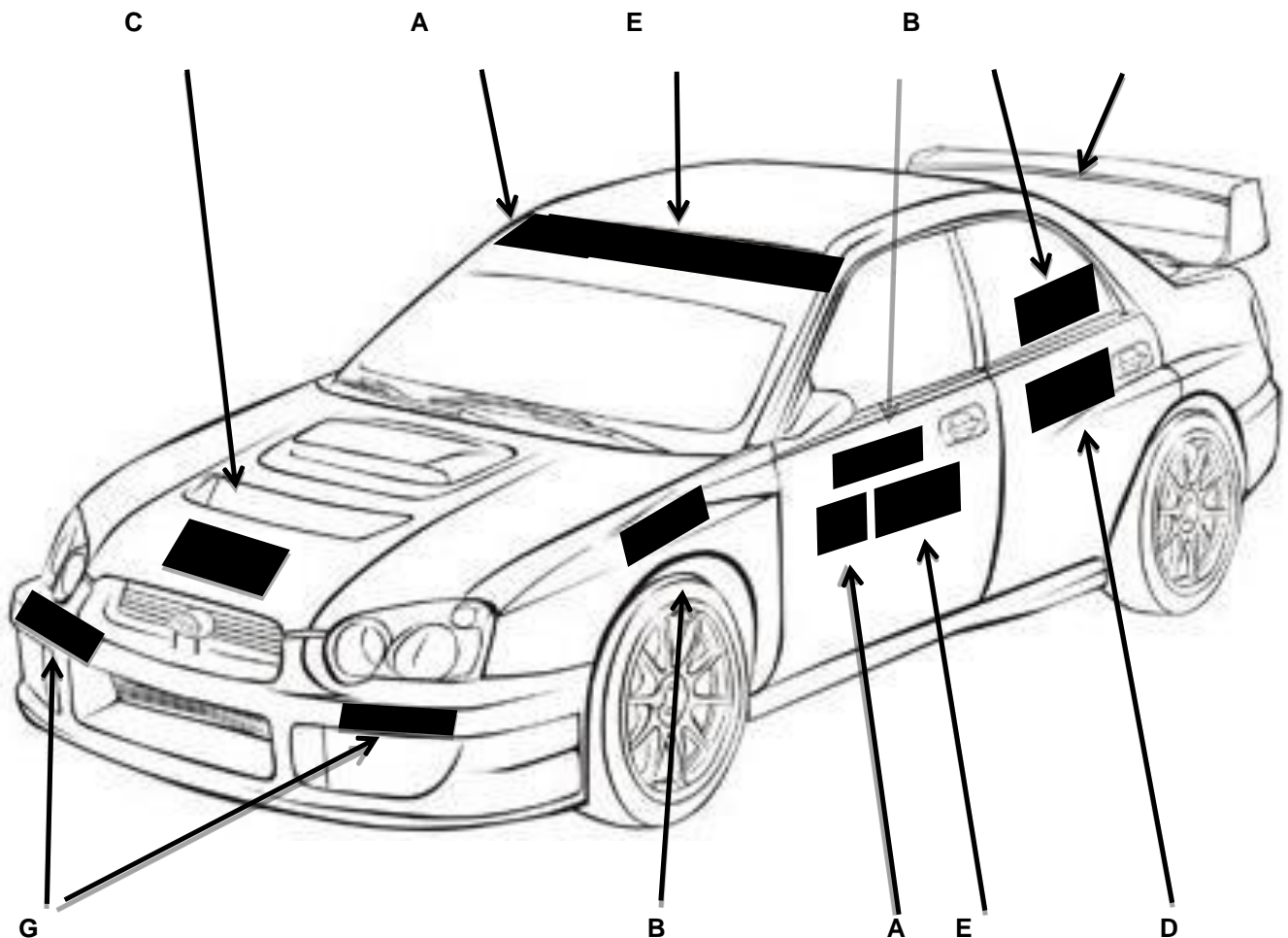
28. Protocol COVID-19
